Dear Portland Riverside Customer,

If you are going to store with us this winter, I urge you to complete the winter storage application and return it to us as soon as you can.

We've had to make small adjustments in our storage and our hourly labor rates, but we're still a great deal compared to most marinas in New England.

I know at this point it is difficult to predict exactly when you will be ready for storage. When you do know, we'd appreciate a call so we can make space for you at the docks. This year, if the weather cooperates, we are going to make every effort to haul boats as soon as we can.

If you have a regular seasonal slip at the marina, please remember that the season ends on October 15. After that we will begin hauling boats to make room for our winter storage customers. If you have a particular need to keep your boat in the water after October 15, we will charge \$350.00 per month or part until your boat is hauled or removed.

We have added a rate for those who wish us to provide storage space for a dingy or inflatable. However, if you store your dingy on or directly under your boat, there is no additional charge.

If you have left a trailer at the marina, please pick it up before the onset of bad weather. When you do, stop at the office and let us know which trailer you are removing. We are going to have to dispose of any orphaned trailers to make room for boat storage.

We've made improvements in the marina and will continue to do so into the fall. When you bring your boat in for winter storage, please stop in at the office.
